## **Event 1: Project Presentation**

### **1. Competition Objectives:**

This competition offers students a platform to showcase their data science projects, insights, and innovations. Please ensure you adhere to the following rules to ensure a fair and smooth competition.

### **2. Conditions and venue of the competition:**

- Open to individual participants or teams of 2 members.
- Venue: National Gallery of Modern Art (NGMA) Auditorium
- Time: 11:00 a.m.
- Link for registration: Same as the registration link.

### **3. Procedure for participation in the competition:**

- Participants have to register before the deadline by completing an online registration form.
- All required fields are to be filled in by each Participant.
- After registering the Participants are entitled to mail the presentation topic with brief report to the Organizers.
- Participants are entitled to mail the presentation to the Organizers 48 hours before the competition.

### **4. Presentation Guidelines:**

- Duration: Each presentation should be of 8 minutes, followed by a 2-minute Q&A session.
- Content: Presentation should cover the problem statement, data collection and pre-processing, methodology, analysis, conclusion and future work.
- Format: Presentations should be in PowerPoint or PDF format.

- Technical Setup: Ensure any required technical setup (software, hardware) is arranged beforehand. The organizers may not be able to support last-minute requests.

## **5. Evaluation Criteria:**

- Problem Solving and Methodology (25%)
- Data analysis (25%)
- Innovations and originality (20%)
- Presentation skills (20%)
- Q&A Performance (10%)

## **6. Code of Conduct:**

- All participants must respect the time limits and maintain professionalism.
- Avoid plagiarism and give proper credit to all sources.
- Offensive or inappropriate content, language, or behavior will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification.

## **7. Prizes:**

Winners will be announced on the day of presentation in the valedictory function and the prizes are as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> place – Rs. 4000
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place – Rs. 3000
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place – Rs. 2000

## **8. Submission and Deadline:**

- Register and submit your project report by 24 November 2024.
- Final presentation should be submitted 48 hours before the event for screening.
